



## Heritage Highlands Men's Golf Association Thirteenth Annual Member-Guest Tournament "CACTUS CLASSIC"

The Thirteenth Annual Men's Member-Guest Tournament, "Cactus Classic", sponsored by the Heritage Highlands Men's Golf Association, will be held Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, March 22nd, 23rd and 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, with an optional practice round on Wednesday March 21<sup>st</sup>. This Tournament is the premier event of our golfing season and the field will be limited to the first 60 teams who mail their entry form and check, made out to the HHMGA, to the tournament chairman, Wolf Glende, by no later than Monday, February 20th. **We hope you will plan to participate!**

### Competitions

Wednesday, March 21 <sup>st</sup>	Practice Round with optional team skins contest.
Thursday, Friday, Saturday	Five individual best ball matches within each flight, six teams per flight. Ten points are possible per match. One point will be awarded per hole for a win, one-half point for a tie and one point for the overall nine hole match winner. The team that accumulates the most points over the five matches will be the winner of their flight. In the event of a tie for 1 <sup>st</sup> place only, the results of the match between the tied teams will be the decider.  Following match #5, all flight winners will proceed to the 5 <sup>th</sup> hole to commence an alternate shot <b>Horseshot</b> . Teams will be eliminated on successive holes until the final two teams will play hole # 9 to determine the Cactus Classic Champions.

There will be **Closest to the Pin** and **Hole in One** contests during Matches #1, #2, #3, #4 on Thursday and Friday .

An optional flighted chipping contest will be held after lunch on Thursday. This is a team event with \$5.00 entry fee. Cash payouts will be made to the top 20%

An optional flighted putting contest will be held after lunch on Friday. This is a team event with \$5.00 entry fee. Cash payouts will be made to the top 20%

On Friday, during the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> matches, we will offer an optional “**Beat the Pro**” contest on hole number 12. You may bet \$5.00 to \$50.00. If your shot is inside the Pro’s shot and on the green, you earn “Double” your bet in credit in the Golf Shop. If your shot does not beat the Pro, you still earn credit in the amount of your bet.

### Awards & Prize Money

#### Flight winners

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>, in each flight.

#### Overall winners

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Horserace

#### Closest to Pin

4 holes each for members, guests

#### Hole in One

First “Hole in One” on Thursday or Friday on Hole #4

#### Optional Team Buy In

Also called day money, each team may buy in for \$55 at the beginning of the tournament. All money collected in a flight, except \$5 per team, will be paid out to the 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams in each match in that flight. If \$300 is collected per flight, \$60 will be paid out at the conclusion of each match, times five matches. Ties will be split. The remaining \$5 will be pooled to be split with all team members in the flight that wins the championship.

#### Optional Horserace Bet

Prior to the horserace, all participants will have the opportunity to bet \$5.00 per on any of the flight winners. All those who have bet on the winners will split the pot.

### Entry Requirements

Member must be a current member of the Heritage Highlands Men’s Golf Association and have an established 18-hole USGA handicap. Guests must also have an established 18-hole USGA handicap, **but not at Heritage Highlands**. All HHMGA members and their guests are welcome, no matter what their handicap/index. However, for competition purposes, a maximum index of 36.4 will be allowed for any contestant. There will be no maximum handicap differential between partners. Members and Guests will play from Coyote tees or forward, depending on course rating/slope used to establish their handicap. Forward tees will be subject to appropriate tournament handicap adjustment.

Handicaps will be verified as of March 1<sup>st</sup> and 100% of the March 1<sup>st</sup> handicap will be used for the tournament.. Please note, we reserve the right under USGA rule 10.3 to adjust indexes during the tournament for extraordinary scores.

**The response deadline for submittal of the Entry Form is Monday, February 20th. The field will be limited to the first 60 entries received. All entries must be complete and sent via the US Mail. Received entries will be date stamped upon receipt.**
