PLAY DAY POLICIES

USGA RULES OF GOLF APPLY UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED

~ HHWGA Goal ~

No round over 4 hours and 15 minutes

- Tuesday Play Days are **8:00am** shotguns unless otherwise noted
- **Check in with Tournament Chairs *before* going to the Driving Range**
- **Be ready to proceed to your assigned tee at 7:45am**
- **Pairings** ~ Will be posted at the clubhouse patio kiosk and on the HHWGA website after 3 pm on Monday
- **Special event information** regarding sign ups and format details are on the HHWGA Bulletin Board, Patio Kisok and HHWGA website
- Details and signup for **Interclub, AWGA events** are available on the HHWGA Bulletin Board
- Points are awarded weekly to event winners and for attendance
- 1/3 of each flight will receive points. All ties will be paid
- Points accumulate for all regular Tuesday events and are paid out in Golf Shop Credit at the end of the season
- Please make sure to check for Frost Delay

The AWGA recommends keeping the handicap range within flights as narrow as possible

- All individual events will be flighted by Handicap
- Individuals will be put into flights where the flights are as equal in number as possible
- Flight size is not as important as fairness
- **Handicaps** used for play are those in effect the Monday before Tuesday play
- Maximum handicap used for competition is 40
- Handicaps change the 1st and 15th of each month
- **Weekly results:** Posted on the Bulletin Board and on the HHWGA website

Chelsea Info

- **To Play** ~ Sign up on Chelsea before midnight Sunday
- **To Cancel** ~ Do so by 7:15am Tuesday Morning. If you know by Monday noon that you can't play, please notify the Pro Shop so that they can change the sign up sheet. Also please try and contact one of your playing partners
- **Special Note** ~ Chelsea will assess 1 point for HHWGA Tuesday play day

No Show/Cancellation Info

- ***No Show***
 - a. A member who does not cancel is considered a “no show”
 - b. Penalties may be assessed at the discretion of the Tournament Chairs
 - c. After a 3rd “no show,” the Executive Board will decide if further action is necessary, including dropping the individual from the winter roster
- ***Play Day Cancellation***
- Tuesday events will be cancelled by 7:30am through the Golf Shop for severe, inclement weather
- If weather is questionable, and some members want to play, those who play 9 holes will be awarded 1 point for attendance; those who play 18 holes will be awarded points for low gross and low net by flight
- Please check for “Frost Delays”

Scorecards

- Two (2) scorecards will be issued each Tuesday
- Both must agree and be signed, attested and returned to the Golf Shop at the conclusion of the event or disqualification may result
- Any disputes should be settled before turning in the cards

Combo Tournament Quail Tees

- The Combo Tournament Quail Tees are used for All Interclub events held at Heritage Highlands. They are also used for the Championship Flight of the Club Championship Tournament
- The rating is 69.2 and the slope is 119
- Combo Tournament Quail Tees yardage 5082

The breakdown for playing the Combo Tees...

Play from the Quail tees with the following exceptions

- Hole #'s 1, 2, 8, 13, 18 are played from the Hummingbird tees
- Hole # 8 is played as a (five) 5 par

Equitable Stroke Control

- After completion of play, review your scorecard. If you have taken more than the allotted maximum number of strokes on any hole, adjust your score. This “adjusted score is what should be posted. USGA Rules of Golf apply unless otherwise noted

<i>Handicap</i>	<i>Maximum strokes allowed per hole</i>
9 or less	Double Bogey
10-19	7
20-29	8
30-39	9
40 and above	10

Pace of Play

- In an effort to help speed play, we have adopted a ***“Hit and Sit Procedure”***
- Keep up with the group directly in front of you
- Always be ready to hit your shot
- After hitting, get into the cart with your clubs, head covers, etc.
- While waiting to hit your next shot replace your clubs in your bag
- Show courtesy to your playing partners by not interfering with their shots
- While waiting to play figure out the distance and club selection before going to your ball
- If a ball is lost, hit your shot, then help the others searching for the lost ball
- After finishing a hole, proceed to the next tee immediately, then complete your scorecard from the previous hole
- If the game allows you to pick up your ball anywhere on the course without disqualification, do so and take your most likely score or your maximum adjusted score for the hole for posting purposes, marking the score with and X, (example ~ 8x) This is acceptable by the USGA Handicap System

Ringers ~ Birdies ~ Eagles ~ Holes in One ~ Chip-Ins

- Each player is to post her own ringer scores and birdies at the end of each Tuesday Play Day Round
- Individual data cards are alphabetically filed and will be available in the Ballroom
- Records will be periodically audited for accurate posting

Ringers (Eclectic Score)

- A ringer score is the best score you have on any hole during HHWGA Tuesday play
- Record and date your initial round on a hole by hole basis
- With each subsequent round, record and date any improved hole score under that hole
- Awards are given at the end of the season

Birdies ~ Eagles ~ Holes in One

- Record and date these on the reverse side of the Ringer card after each regular Tuesday play
- This a cumulative record, so enter all, even if duplicated on the same hole

Chip-Ins

- Sign up and pay 50 cents at the chip-in table the morning of Tuesday play
- Record and attest any Chip-Ins on the reverse side of the designated scorecard
- Money is awarded weekly
